WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR  
IN-SITU REMEDIATION PILOT TEST  
AT FORMER SANMINA PLANT I AND MICHELSON PLAZA  
IRVINE, ORANGE COUNTY**

**TENTATIVE ORDER R8-2024-0016**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board (Santa Ana Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment tentative Order R8-2024-0016 (Tentative Order), which will serve as Waste Discharge Requirements for the discharge of chemical amendments into the subsurface at Former Sanmina Plant 1 (18522 Von Karman Avenue, Irvine) and Michelson Plaza (2400 Michelson Drive, Irvine) to conduct a pilot test for groundwater remediation of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) within the specified treatment zone (in-situ). With proper management and monitoring as required by the Tentative Order and associated Monitoring and Reporting Program, any potential adverse effects of the pilot test will be localized, of short duration, and are not expected to unreasonably impair any existing or prospective beneficial uses of groundwater. Such comments will generally be limited to three minutes, though the Board Chair may grant additional time on a case-by-case basis.
