NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

TENTATIVE ORDER R8-2025-0053

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board (Santa Ana Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment tentative Revision Order R8-2024-0053 (Tentative Order), which will amend Order R8-2013-0035 (Affected Order) to substitute permittees and update the subject facility's name.

Adopted on July 19, 2013, the Affected Order prescribes Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the facility previously known as the Chino Valley Truck Wash, and previously owned and operated by Mr. Curt Van Diest. The subject facility is now owned by De Vries Properties, LLC, and operated by Chino Valley Tank Wash, LLC and Mr. Shad Skikos. The subject facility has also been renamed as "Chino Valley Tank Wash." Apart from changing the name of the subject facility and transferring permit coverage, no other substantive changes to the Affected Order are proposed at this time.

The Tentative Order will be considered for adoption at a public meeting that will occur at the following date, time and location:

Interested persons may attend and express their views orally on this matter at the public hearing. Oral statements should be brief to allow all interested persons time to be heard. Such comments will generally be limited to three minutes, though the Board Chair may grant additional time as deemed appropriate on a case-by-case basis.

The Santa Ana Water Board's agenda for the Board meeting will be available on the Santa Ana Water Board's <u>Agenda</u> webpage at least ten days prior to the meeting. Please check the Santa Ana Water Board's website for the most up-to-date public hearing date and location, as they are subject to change.

SUBMISSION OF WRITTEN COMMENTS

The Santa Ana Water Board will accept written comments on the Tentative Order during a 30-day public comment period. Persons wishing to submit written comments on the Tentative Order are requested to do so as soon as possible, but comments must be received no later than 5:00 pm on **June 5, 2025**.
