TENTATIVE ORDER R8-2025-0082

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board (Santa Ana Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment tentative Order R8-2025-0082 (Tentative Order) to San Bernardino County Department of Public Works (Discharger) for the San Timoteo Canyon Landfill Stockpile 3 Project (Project).

The Project purpose is to prepare and establish a stockpile area ("Stockpile 3") for the excavated earthen material from the San Timoteo Sanitary Landfill as part of Unit 2, Phase 5 landfill expansion. The stockpile area will accommodate up to 2,700,000 cubic yards of excavated earthen materials. The Project would result in the permanent physical loss of 0.91 acre of ephemeral streambed to waters of the State as a result of filling a drainage feature to place the stockpile material.

The Santa Ana Water Board intends to consider adopting the Tentative Order during a public hearing at a regularly scheduled Santa Ana Water Board meeting as follows:
