## REQUEST BY FRANKLIN FUELING SYSTEMS FOR CONSTRUCTION CHANGES TO THE DEFENDER SERIES OVERFILL PREVENTION VALVE IN EXECUTIVE ORDER VR-101

On January 20, 2020, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) received an information packet from Franklin Fueling Systems requesting a review of the Defender Series Overfill Prevention Valve (OPV) in Executive Order (EO) Vapor Recovery (VR)-101, Phil-Tite Phase I for Enhanced Vapor Recovery (EVR) Systems. This notice is to inform you that the State Water Board has no determination to make regarding the proposed modification to EO VR-101, Phil-Tite Phase I.

State Water Board staff have reviewed the proposed design changes to components of the Defender Series OPV, as described in the letter from Franklin Fueling Systems dated January 20, 2020, and have concluded that the proposed modifications do not affect the compatibility or functionality of the OPV, and therefore, do not affect the EVR determination previously issued by the State Water Board for EOs VR-101, Phil-Tite Phase I for EVR Systems.
