This amendment provides a twelve (12) month extension to the due date of the compensatory mitigation financial assurances instrument.

On March 12, 2014, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) issued a Clean Water Act (CWA) section 401 water quality certification (Certification) for the High Speed Train Project – Merced to Fresno Permitting Phase 1 (Project). On April 7, 2014, the High Speed Rail Authority requested a time extension for providing a financial assurances instrument for compensatory mitigation to the State Water Resources Control Board as required in Additional Condition Number 50 and Attachment F of the March 12, 2014 Clean Water Act Section 401 Water Quality Certification.

Pursuant to title 23, section 3838 of the California Code of Regulations, Enclosed is the amended Certification for the Project. Attachments A through G of the enclosure are part of this Certification.
