







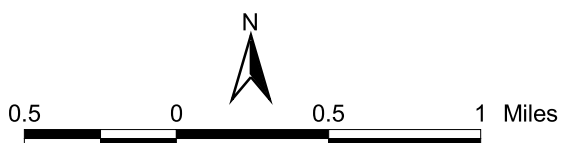
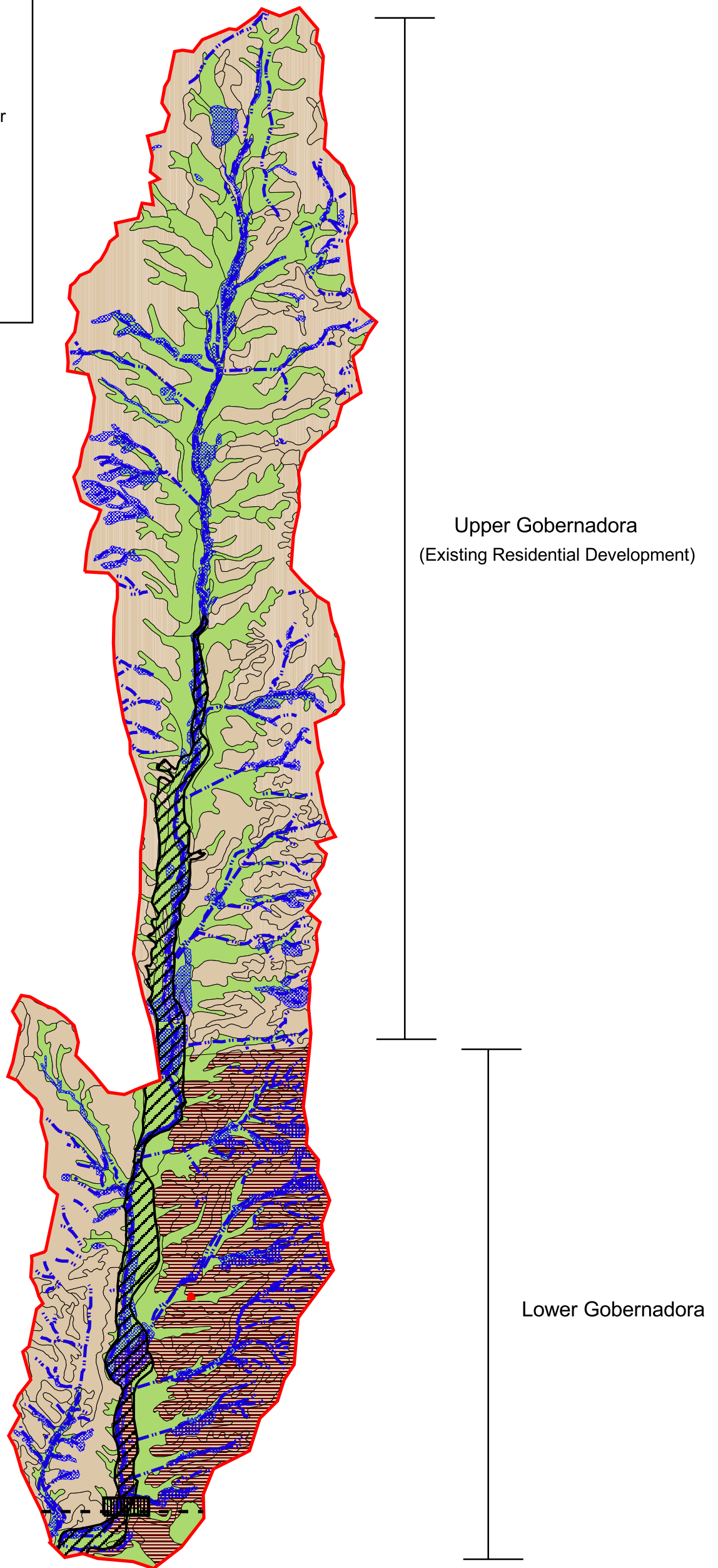


-  Infiltration Areas/Sandy Swales
