21	Plaintiff, THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF	CALIFORNIA, having filed their complaint	
22	herein, JAMES C. BRAZELTON, District Attorney of Stanislaus County, by and through GLORIA M.		
23	MAS, Deputy District Attorney of Stanislaus County, and defendant WRIGHT'S PETROLEUM INC.		
24	(DBA), hereby stipulate and consent to the entry of the Permanent Injunction and Final Judgment		
25	Pursuant to Stipulation. By signing this stipulation, these named defendants hereby admit the		
26	allegations of the complaint. This stipulation is entered into based in part on representations made and		
27	reaffirmed by these named defendants herein, that certain penalty payments will be made according to		
72	the terms of the Stipulated Final Judgment. This Stipulated Final Judgment shall constitute evidence		
	of admission or concession by these named defendants i	regarding all allegations of law and fact alleged

2	in the complaint on file herein.		
3	Upon the consent of the parties hereto, and it appearing to the court that there is good cause for		
4	the entry of this Stipulated Final Judgment,		
5	IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:		
6	1. This court has jurisdiction of the subject matter of this action and each of the parties		
7	hereto.		
8	2. The injunctive provisions of this Final Judgment are applicable to defendants, its		
9	subsidiaries and divisions, and any agent, employee, representative and all persons, partners,		
10	corporations, or other entities acting by, through, under, or on behalf of defendants and all persons in		
11	concert with or participating with said defendants with actual or constructive knowledge of this		
12	injunction, only insofar as they are doing business in the State of California and confined to defendants'		
13	dairy operations in the County of STANISLAUS and throughout the state of California.		
14	3. Pursuant to Business and Practice Code §17203, Defendants are hereby permanently		
15	enjoined from:		
16	a) Violating any environmental offenses, including but not limited to §25299 of the Health		
17	and Safety Code.		
18	4. Defendants shall pay the sum of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) in civil		
19	penalties to be paid as follows:		
20	a) Defendants shall pay FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00), as civil penalties,		
21	including partial cost recovery, pursuant to Health and Safety Code § 25299. This civil penalty		
22	amount shall be made payable to the Stanislaus County Treasurer Department of		
23	Environmental Resources.		
24	These penalties shall be STAYED for a period of three (3) years, beginning the filing of this		
25	Stipulated Judgment, on the condition that no further violations occur pursuant to this		
26	agreement. It is understood that this stayed \$500.00 portion of the civil penalty shall		
27	immediately be due and owed on this case if any future violations occur as described in section		

3a. If no violations occur during the three-year period, the stay will become permanent.

3	5. In addition, defendants shall pay the sum of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) to		
4	a Supplemental Environmental Program, and/or Recovery Costs, as follows:		
5			
6	a) Defendant shall pay the sum of TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00), payable to		
7	the Secretary of the California Environmental Protection Agency. This money shall be		
8	deposited into the Environmental Enforcement and Training Account established by		
9	Assembly Bill 2486 (2002, Keeley) under the authority of Penal Code § 14301.		
10			
11	b) Defendant shall pay the sum of TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00), payable to		
12	the Stanislaus County Department of Environmental Resources. Such money is to be		
13	used for environmental offenses to conduct investigation, prosecution and remediation.		
14			
15	c) Defendant shall pay the sum of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)		
16	payable to the California State Water Resources Control Board.		
17			
18	6. Defendant shall pay the sum of FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY DOLLARS AND THIRTY		
19	CENTS (\$580.30) payable to the Stanislaus County Superior Court for filing fees.		
20			
21	7. Defendants waive all objections to, employees from the CSWRCB and the Department		
22	of Environmental Resources, entering upon their business operations in Stanislaus, CA, for the		
23	purpose of inspection and enforcement of the terms of this agreement.		
24			
25	8. All checks shall be sent to the Stanislaus County District Attorney's Office, attention:		
26	Donna Robinson, Stanislaus County Courthouse, P.O. Box 442, Modesto, CA 95353. All amounts		
27	except the filing fee, are due within sixty (60) of the filing of this Final Judgment. The filing fee is due
