**PROJECT LOCATION:** The Project site is located within an approximately 40-acre rural residential area (APN 005-180-005-000) approximately three miles southwest of lone in Amador County.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is the Lead Agency for the Project. The Project includes the installation of a new water distribution system to provide potable water to 14 existing residences. The existing water distribution system would remain in place to provide water for irrigation and fire protection services only, while a new distribution system connected to the Jackson Valley Irrigation District would provide potable water to the 14 existing residences.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The State Water Board has approved the Project described above on September 10, 2025. The Ione Band of Miwok Indians will be carrying out the Project. The State Water Board has made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations regarding the Project:

- 2. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
