Item 1 – Introductions

Item 4 - Fee Changes

- Open Discussion and Questions
 - There was discussion regarding the following:
 - 20% is the recommended prudent fund reserve amount.
 - The fee increase option being recommended by OOC is option one
 (1).

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- The number of operators being renewed varies each year, which is a good example of why revenue may vary each year. The proposed regulation change of eliminating the 60-day waiting period for examinations is another variable that may affect revenue.
- A104% fee increase would be required to close the gap between expenditures and revenue in one (1) year rather than spreading it over three (3) years. The WWOCP is required to collect sufficient revenue to cover all program expenditures, but it would be undesirable to increase fees 104% in one (1) year.
- Review of fee schedule prior to the 2017 fee schedule reductions.
- Inflation consideration.
- Different fee increase options to ensure the collection of sufficient revenue.
- The Advisory Committee members proposal for a higher more consistent rate of increase over a three (3) year period.

 In conclusion, the Advisory Committee would prefer a higher more consistent rate of increase over a three (3) year period. Keisha Kelley thanked the Advisory Committee members who attended in person.
