NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will accept comments on the proposed approval of an amendment to the Basin Plan that would adopt TMDLs for dissolved copper, lead, and zinc in Chollas Creek, which is tributary to San Diego Bay.
