NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN AMENDMENT TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY REGION (BASIN PLAN) TO ESTABLISH A TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD (TMDL) AND IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR PATHOGENS IN THE NAPA RIVER WATERSHED

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will now accept comments on an amendment to the Basin Plan that would establish a TMDL and implementation plan for pathogens in the Napa River Watershed. Both the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board's (San Francisco Bay Water Board's) amendment and the State Water Board item language and draft resolution are available on the State Water Board's Web site at http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/tmdl/tmdl.html or can be received by mail by contacting Mitchell Goode at (916) 341-5726. The State Water Board will send a notice of a future meeting at which the item will be considered.

Resolution No. R2-2006-0079, adopted on November 13, 2006 by the San Francisco Bay Water Board, modified the regulatory provisions of the Basin Plan by establishing the TMDL and implementation plan to reduce pathogen-related risks to humans and restore and protect water quality and beneficial uses.

Comment letters <u>must be received by 12 p.m. on **June 29, 2007**.</u> After the June deadline, State Water Board staff will not accept additional written comments unless the State Water Board determines that such comments should be accepted.
