3 Year Extension

- **Qualify**
 - Operating permit prior to Winery Order
 - Region 2
- **Apply**
- **Compliance**
 - Reporting
 - Operations
 - Fees

Operating Permits for Process Waste

State

- Winery Order

Regional Board

- Individual WDR

County

- Hold & Haul
- Previously regulated
- Engineered Systems
- Ponds
- Conventional >1500g/d

Sanitation district

- Pretreatment and discharge to sewer system

No Permit

- Conventional producing less than 10,000 gallons of PW a year

Currently...

New Wineries

- Directly to Order

Existing Wineries – Not permitted with Napa

- Order Deadline **Jan 2024**

Existing Wineries – Permitted with Napa

- Remain in compliance
- No expansion***
 - Triggers
 - Increase in process waste
 - Increase in domestic wastewater (commingled)
 - Changes (or addition) in treatment
 - Changes in disposal method
 - Order Exempt

Self-certification

- County Operating Permit may be required

Timeline

Use Permit

- Use Permit process
- New or Expanding

County and State Order

- Building & Environmental Health
- NOI & NOA with Winery Order

Construction

- NOA must be issued prior to Napa County permit issuance

Operation

- Must meet the requirements of the NOA

Looking forward...

3 Year Extension

Ends January 2027

Local Agency

Enforce the operating permits for the Winery Order

Moving forward...

Right Now (Napa County regulated)

- Begin water quality sampling
- Gather flow data

Plan for upgrades

- Determine what will be needed
- Area-wide monitoring well network for Tier 4
