O R D E R

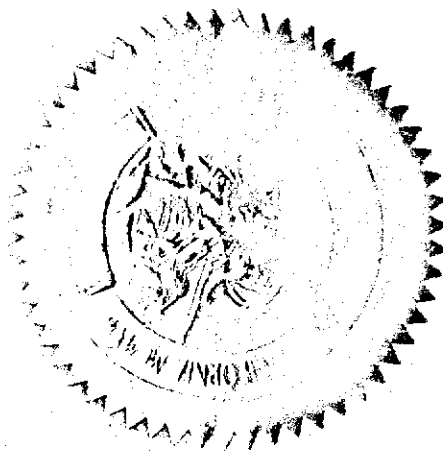
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applications 6873 and 7091 be cancelled upon the records of the Division of Water Resources without prejudice.
