ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT

In the Matter of the Violation of an Emergency Regulation for Failure to Submit Information of Water Diversion and Use by

PARTIES LISTED IN ATTACHMENT A (MILL CREEK WATERSHED)

BY THE ASSISTANT DEPUTY DIRECTOR FOR WATER RIGHTS¹

On December 15, 2015, the Assistant Deputy Director for the Division of Water Rights of the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) issued an Administrative Civil Liability Complaint (Complaint) to the parties listed in Attachment A (collectively "Parties") for failure to fulfill obligations under State Water Board Order WR 2015-0026-DWR². After receipt of the Complaint, the Parties submitted the required water use and supply information to the State Water Board, fulfilling the substantive requirements of Order WR 2015-0026-DWR.

The central condition of the Settlement Offer was to get the Parties' submittal of water use and supply information to the State Water Board, and the Parties have subsequently fulfilled that obligation. The circumstances here support accepting the submission of the information as de facto acceptance of the Settlement Offer.

I hereby approve Settlement of the Complaints pursuant to my delegated authority. This approval shall not limit the authority of the Executive Director or the Deputy Director for Water Rights, as delegated, to initiate enforcement action for any violations not specified in the Complaint.

¹ Water Code section 1055, subdivision (a), provides that the Executive Director of the State Water Board may issue a complaint to any person or entity on whom Administrative Civil Liability (ACL) may be imposed. The Executive Director has delegated this authority to the Deputy Director for Water Rights, who has redelegated this authority to the Assistant Deputy Director for Water Rights. State Water Board Resolution No. 2012 - 0029 authorizes the Deputy Director for Water Rights to issue an order imposing an ACL when a complaint has been issued and no hearing has been requested within 20 days of receipt of the complaint. The Deputy Director for Water Rights has redelegated this authority to the Assistant Deputy Director for Water Rights.
