Notice of Water Right Application A032317

Butts Canyon Ranch LLC has filed an application to appropriate water by permit with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights. The project associated with the application is located in Napa County and would divert water from the Putah Creek stream system.

Summary of Water Right Application A032317

Date of Filing: The application was filed with the State Water Board on November 25, 2014.

Source of Water: The source of water is an Unnamed Stream, which is tributary to Butts Creek thence Putah Creek thence the Sacramento River.

Diversion Method and Amount: Water will be diverted by collection to storage, and will be limited to 20.2 acre-feet per year.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water is from September 1 of each year to June 14 of the succeeding year.

Point of Diversion: The point where water will be diverted is located at North 2,013,419 feet and East 6,435,850 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 29, Township 10 North, Range 5 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Purposes of Use: The purposes of use for water are recreation and fire protection.

Places of Use: The places of use for water are the reservoir for recreation use and Napa County parcel 016-130-004-000 for fire protection use.

Protests must be received by the Division of Water Rights or postmarked by **August 4, 2025**, with copy provided to the applicant.
