# **Notice of Water Right Application A033508**

The City of Monterey has filed an application to appropriate water by permit with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights. The project associated with the application is located in Monterey County and would divert water from the Lake El Estero stream system.

### **Summary of Water Right Application A033508**

Date of Filing: The application was filed with the State Water Board on July 18, 2025.

**Source of Water:** The source of water is Lake El Estero, which is tributary to the Pacific Ocean.

**Diversion Method and Amount:** Water will be diverted to underground storage in the Seaside Groundwater Basin and will be limited to 500 acre-feet per year at a rate not to exceed 8.24 cubic feet per second.

**Season of Diversion:** The season for diversion of water to storage is January 1 to December 31 of each year.

**Points of Diversion:** The point where water will be diverted is located at North 2,114,106 feet and East 5,715,164 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 4, North American Datum 1983, within the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 29, Township 15 South, Range 1 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

**Purpose of Use:** The purpose of use for water is municipal.

**Place of Use:** The place of use for water is the Monterey District Service Area of California American Water, which totals 33,950 acres and includes the cities of Monterey, Pacific Grove, Del Rey Oaks and Carmel by the Sea, and portions of the City of Seaside and unincorporated Monterey County.
