Notice of Temporary Permit Application T033519

Yolo County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (YCFC&WCD) has filed an application to appropriate water by permit with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights, pursuant to Water Code section 1425 et seq. The project associated with the application is located in Yolo County and would divert water from the Cache Creek stream system. The Applicant requests authorization to appropriate surface water for underground storage as described below.

Summary of Water Right Application T033519

Type of Temporary Permit: 180-day

Date of Filing: The application was filed with the State Water Board on September 3, 2025

Source of Water: The source of water is Cache Creek, which is tributary to the Sacramento River, thence the Pacific Ocean.

Amount: The maximum amount of water requested for diversion is 14,999 acre-feet, which would be diverted at a rate not to exceed 600 cubic feet per second.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water is from January 1st, 2026, to April 15th, 2026.

Points of Diversion: The point where water would be diverted is located at North 2,021,619 feet and East 6,537,481 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the NE (¼) quarter of the SE (¼) quarter of Section 16, Township 10 North, Range 02 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Purpose of Use: The purpose of use is irrigation.

Place of Use: The water would be used within 100,000 acres of the YCFC&WCD service area boundary.

Location and Type of Infiltration: Surface water percolation would occur throughout the district's 160-mile unlined canal system and on up to 50,000 acres of land within the district, using water diverted from the Cache Creek stream system via the Capay Diversion dam.

Use Accounting: The water stored underground in the Yolo Subbasin would serve irrigation uses within the District. The water used would be tracked by measuring the

volume of applied water at each turnout gate used in this effort; in addition, "last in and first out" or LIFO methods will be used to ensure that recharge waters are the first water utilized by overlying groundwater users. Groundwater levels will be monitored using YCFC&WCD's various groundwater monitoring wells.

Water Rights Records Database

Documentation related to temporary permit applications were previously available through the State Water Board's electronic Water Rights Information Management System (eWRIMS) database, but that system is currently unavailable. Procedure for Filing Objections

Pursuant to Water Code section 1428, any interested person may file an objection against the approval of the subject application. Objections should be submitted via email to the staff contact listed below but may also be submitted via regular mail or hand delivered. If objections are sent by mail or hand delivered, please provide a courtesy email to the staff contact listed below.

Objections must be received by the Division of Water Rights or postmarked by **October 13, 2025**, with copy provided to the applicant. The State Water Board may, for good cause shown, allow additional time to file an objection.

Pursuant to Water Code section 1428, the board may issue a temporary permit in advance of public notice. Consequently, a temporary permit may be issued on the application before the end of the noticing period.
