NOTICE OF PETITION FOR CHANGE AND EXTENSION OF TIME FOR PETITION 20985 (APPLICATION 29901)

COUNTY: Sonoma

STREAM SYSTEM: Russian River

The Russian River County Water District (Petitioner) filed a petition for extension of time and change in the place of use for Permit 20985 (Application 29901) on May 14, 2008 and December 23, 2008, respectively. The Petitioner seeks a 10-year extension (until December 31, 2015) to complete full beneficial use. Amount:	0.66 cubic feet per second by direct diversion. The maximum diversion shall not exceed 302 acre-feet per annum.
