REVISED NOTICE OF WASTEWATER CHANGE PETITION WW0059

COUNTY: San Bernardino STREAM SYSTEM: Santa Ana River

City of San Bernardino Municipal Water Department, 300 N. D. Street, 5th Floor, San Bernardino, California 92418 has filed a wastewater change petition, seeking to change the place of use, purpose of use, and reduce the discharge quantity of treated wastewater by up to 43.5 cubic feet per second (cfs), with an annual reduction in discharges of up to 31,500 acre-feet (af).
