Description of Proposed Transfer of Water

An estimated 9,131.31 acre-feet of water will be made available for transfer by following 4,287 acres of agricultural land on Webb Tract in the Sacramento River – San Joaquin River Delta. Water that would have been consumptively use will be made available to Semitropic Water Storage District in order to facilitate delivery of water banked in the Semitropic Groundwater Storage Bank to Alameda County Water District, the City of Tracy, Santa Clara Valley Water District, and Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, Zone 7.

Water conserved under License 1572 would be conveyed through existing facilities by the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) via Banks Pumping Plant or the United States Bureau of Reclamation (USBR) via Tracy Pumping Plant to: (a) Alameda County Water District, Santa Clara Valley Water District, and Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, Zone 7 via the California Aqueduct to the South Bay Aqueduct; (b) the City of Tracy via the Delta Mendota Canal; and (c) Kern County Water Agency via the California Aqueduct.

Photographs

The present points of diversion and the present places of use include existing facilities and areas documented in Water Right Decision 1643 and other information on file with the Division of Water Rights. The proposed new points of diversion, Banks Pumping Plant and Jones Pumping Plant, and proposed places of use, Alameda County Water District, the City of Tracy, Santa Clara Valley Water District, and Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, Zone 7 service areas, are well known and documented in Division of Water Right files. Accordingly, photographs of the points of diversion and places of use are not included in this petition but will be provided upon request.

Maps

Maps for the present points of diversion and place of use are located in Division of Water Rights file for License 1572. Maps for the proposed new points of diversion, Banks Pumping Plant and Jones Pumping Plant, and proposed places of use, Alameda County Water District, the City of Tracy, Santa Clara Valley Water District, and Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, Zone 7 service areas are located in Division of Water Rights files for various permits and licenses for the Central Valley Project and State Water Project.
