NOTICE OF TEMPORARY URGENCY CHANGE PETITIONS FOR LICENSE 13527A (APPLICATION 30049A) AND PERMIT 20770B (APPLICATION 30049B) OF HIDDEN VALLEY LAKE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

COUNTY: LAKE

STREAM SYSTEM: PUTAH CREEK

On July 22, 2016, Hidden Valley Lake Community Services District filed two temporary urgency change petitions with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights requesting approval of temporary changes to water right License 13527A and Permit 20770B pursuant to Chapter 6.6 of Part 2 of Division 2 of the Water Code. The petitions seek authorization to temporarily suspend mandated supplemental water releases to Putah Creek between July 15 and October 31, 2016 to help conserve municipal water supply in anticipation of continuing drought conditions.
