NOTICE OF PETITION FOR TEMPORARY CHANGE INVOLVING THE TRANSFER OF UP TO 2,000 ACRE-FEET OF WATER FROM CARMICHAEL WATER DISTRICT TO STATE WATER CONTRACTOR AGENCIES UNDER LICENSE 1387 (APPLICATION 138)

Carmichael Water District (CWD) filed a petition on May 1, 2020, for temporary change with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights, to transfer up to 2,000 acre-feet of water pursuant to Water Code section 1725 et seq., under water right License 1387 (Application 138). CWD proposes to transfer the water from May 2020 through November 2020 to six State Water Contractor Agencies: Dudley Ridge Water District, Kern County Water Agency, Tulare Lake Basin Water Storage District, County of Kings, Palmdale Water District, and Alameda County Water Agency. The transfer water would be made available at proposed additional point of diversion and point of rediversion by groundwater substitution for surface water under License 1387. The proposed transfer would include the following changes to CWD's License 1387: (1) add the State Water Project's Harvey O. Banks Pumping Plant as a point of diversion, (2) add San Luis Reservoir as a point of rediversion, (3) add a portion of the State Water Project's service area as an additional place of use, and (4) add municipal and industrial purposes of use.

Pursuant to California Water Code section 1726(f), any interested person may file a comment regarding the petition. Comments filed in response to this notice should be submitted to the persons listed below and must be received by 4:30 p.m. on June 10, 2020.
