Dear Hearing Officers Doduc and Marcus,

Despite huge changes in the California WaterFix (CWF) project in the South Delta, the California Department of Water Resources' (DWR) and the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation's (USBR) Part 2 Rebuttal testimony does not include among other things Engineering or Operations & Maintenance testimony.

At the beginning of the CWF hearing, Petitioners clearly stated that all Clifton Court, L.P.'s (CCLP) property would be taken. Now Petitioners claim that no property will be taken. CCLP believes their Senior Water Rights will be injured. CCLP would like all panels from Part 1 to address changes in the proposed project and be available for questions from CCLP. CCLP would like to be given the same due process that all other Legal Users of Water/Protestants were afforded in Part 1.

CCLP looks forward to presenting its rebuttal testimony. Sheldon Moore & Suzanne Womack each have 30 minutes of expert testimony to present.
