NOTICE OF ADOPTION HEARING

2009 DRAFT PERIODIC REVIEW STAFF REPORT OF THE 2006 WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY/SACRAMENTO-SAN JOAQUIN DELTA ESTUARY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board or Board) will hold a public hearing at a regularly scheduled Board meeting to consider adopting the <u>2009 Draft Periodic Review Staff Report (Staff Report)</u> of the 2006 Water Quality Control Plan for the San Francisco Bay/ Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Estuary (Bay-Delta Plan). The location and time of the Board meeting, during which the hearing will be held, are provided below.

This notice also advises interested persons that the State Water Board will receive public comments on the Staff Report of the Bay-Delta Plan for a 30-day period ending at 12:00 Noon on Monday, June 15, 2009. The agenda for the July 7 Board meeting and the draft resolution adopting the Staff Report will be provided at a later date.

BACKGROUND

Under its authority to regulate water quality in the state, on December 13, 2006, the State Water Board adopted the Bay-Delta Plan pursuant to Resolution 2006-0098. Water Code section 13240 requires that water quality control plans be periodically reviewed. Federal Clean Water Act section 303(c) (33 U.S.C., § 1313(c)) requires a triennial review of state water quality "standards," as defined in the Act. Accordingly, the State Water Board is conducting this review of the Bay-Delta Plan.

The State Water Board initiated its periodic review of the Bay-Delta Plan on August 29, 2008, by issuing a notice of a public workshop and soliciting comments on elements of the Bay-Delta Plan that may need amendment, new elements that should be added, or whether the entire plan should be revised. The State Water Board held a public workshop on October 8, 2008. After considering the comments received and other information, State Water Board staff has prepared a Staff Report identifying certain water quality issues that should be further investigated in this Bay-Delta water quality control planning process. The Staff Report contains recommendations as to the elements of the Bay-Delta Plan that the State Water Board should potentially consider amending, possible new elements that the State Water Board should not include as priorities in the water quality control planning process. The State Water Board's adoption of this Staff Report will mark the completion of the current periodic review. This

review, however, does not mean that any revision will be made to the Bay-Delta Plan, but instead establishes priorities for further investigation of issues that may result in plan amendments. The State Water Board will then proceed with a process that may lead to a revised Bay-Delta Plan or amendments to the Bay-Delta Plan.
