## NOTICE OF VIOLATION: FAILURE TO FILE ANNUAL DIVERSION AND USE REPORT

To Whom It May Concern:

Based on our records, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division) determined that you are the Primary Owner or Agent for the water right listed on the reverse page. You are required to file annual water diversion and use reports to the State Water Board even if no water was diverted or used.

As of the date of this letter, the Division has not received your October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022 water year (2021-2022 water year) diversion report(s) that was due before **February 1, 2023**. This is a violation of section \_\_\_\_\_ of Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations. Additionally, due to your diversion size, you are also required to submit information regarding measuring devices and data collected from those devices at a frequency commensurate with your diversion as specified in the measurement regulations (Title 23, Chapter 2.8, sections 931-938 of the California Code of Regulations).

Water Code section 1846 grants the Board authority to impose administrative civil liability (ACL) not to exceed \$500 for each day your water diversion and use report(s) was not filed. As of the date of this letter, the maximum potential fine is \$ (186 days from the February 1, 2023 deadline for the 2021-2022 water year diversion report).

The Division will NOT issue an ACL Complaint for this violation if you submit your 2021-2022 water year diversion report(s) no later than August 25, 2023.

You can submit each report online at <a href="https://rms.waterboards.ca.gov">https://rms.waterboards.ca.gov</a> with the Water Right ID and Password listed below. <a href="Separate reports must be filed for each water right or claim of right you own or manage">or claim of right you own or manage</a>. Do not combine information for multiple water rights or claims on one response.

If you are no longer the legal owner of the water right(s) or claim(s) of right listed, provide proof to the Division at the contact information provided below by August 18, 2023, and we will not issue an ACL Complaint.
