## NOTICE OF VIOLATION: FAILURE TO FILE ANNUAL DIVERSION AND USE REPORT

Dear Frances A Wignall Living Trust of 2003:

Based on our records, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division) determined that you are the Primary Owner for the water right(s) or claim(s) of right listed on the reverse page. You are required to file annual water diversion and use reports to the State Water Board even if no water was diverted or used.

As of the date of this letter, the Division has not received your October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022 water year (2021-2022 water year) diversion report(s) that was due before **February 1, 2023**. This is a violation of section 920 of Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations. Due to your diversion size you must also submit information regarding your measuring devices and data collected from those devices. The frequency of data collection depends on the size of your diversion or reservoir. Your diversion requires a weekly data collection (Title 23, Chapter 2.8, sections 931-938 of the California Code of Regulations).

Water Code section 1846 authorizes the Board to impose administrative civil liability (ACL) of up to \$500 for each day after the deadline your water diversion and use report(s) was not filed. As of the date of this letter, the maximum potential fine is \$116,500 per report (233 days from the February 1, 2023 deadline for the 2021-2022 water year diversion report).

The Division will NOT issue an ACL Complaint for this violation if you submit your 2021-2022 water year diversion report(s) by October 21, 2023.
