In accordance with the State Water Resources Control Board's (State Water Board) Notice of Public Hearing (Notice), dated April 19, 2010, enclosed is a Service List of Parties who have submitted a Notice of Intent to Appear (NOI) and who have indicated intent to participate in the hearing. The Service List also identifies interested persons who have submitted NOIs expressing their intent to present a policy statement only. Copies of the NOIs are attached.

As a reminder, the hearing officers will conduct a pre-hearing conference to discuss the scope of the hearing and any other procedural issues at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 27, 2010. Interested persons who are only planning to present a policy statement and will not be participating in the evidentiary portion of the hearing are not required to attend the pre-hearing conference. All parties are required to attend. Parties may attend by teleconference to avoid traveling to Sacramento for a relatively short meeting. If you intend to participate by teleconference, please contact either Paul Murphey at (916) 341-5435 or Larry Lindsay at (916) 341-5358 by close of business on Wednesday, May 26, 2010 to obtain the phone number and access code.

The goal of the pre-hearing conference is to ensure that the hearing proceeds in an orderly and expeditious manner. The pre-hearing conference will not be used to hear arguments on, or determine the merits of any hearing issues, other than procedural matters, unless the parties agree to resolve a hearing issue by stipulation. Following the pre-hearing conference, the State Water Board may, at its discretion, modify the hearing procedures or issues set forth in the April 19th Notice in whole or in part. Failure to attend the pre-hearing conference may result in exclusion from participation in the hearing.

As instructed in Section 4 of the April 19th Notice's attachment entitled, "Information Concerning Appearance at Water Right Hearings," each party shall submit to the State Water Board either: seven paper copies of each of its exhibits or five paper copies and one electronic copy of each of its exhibits no later than 12 Noon, Tuesday, June 29, 2010. Please see Section 5 of the Notice's attachment for details regarding electronic submissions. With exhibits, each party must submit to the State Water Board and serve on the other parties a completed "Exhibit Identification Index." Please submit the "Exhibit Identification Index" to the State Water Board in either Microsoft Word or Excel format. All of the required copies must be received by the 12 Noon, June 29, 2010 deadline. Each party shall also serve a copy of each exhibit on every party on the service list. Parties may serve those parties who agree to electronic service with
