NOTICE REQUESTING NEW MONO LAKE INFORMATION

State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board or Board) staff will hold one or more public workshops in 2026 to collect information on the condition of Mono Basin's public trust resources and evaluate potential management options. The workshop(s) will focus on new data that have been collected since the Board issued Water Right Decision 1631 (D-1631) in 1994. State Water Board staff are requesting public input on the topics that will be covered at the workshop(s).

Background

The State Water Board heard an [information item on Mono Lake modeling efforts](#) at its March 17, 2026, public meeting. During the meeting, the Board directed its staff to prepare for a hearing to determine whether Mono Basin water diversions should be modified to reach Mono Lake's legally mandated water management level, and to hold one or more staff workshops to gather information on the condition of Mono Basin's public trust resources and potential management options.
