Conditional Water Availability in Watersheds with State-Filed Applications

### *When Used:*

Permits issued on applications where water availability findings are determined without consideration of the demand of an unassigned State-Filed Application.

### *Background/Justification:*

Wat. Code §§ 100, 105, 1058, 1202, subd. (c), 1253, 1375, subd. (d), 1410-1410.2, 1675-1675.2.

## TERM 121

Water is available to supply this right only if the unassigned, senior demand of State-Filed Application A0\*#####\* is not considered. In the case of a future assignment of A0\*#####\*, this right will be subject to revocation if the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) determines that sufficient water is no longer available for appropriation under this right.

Water is conditionally determined to be available for this right for the reasons included in the water right issuance order on file with the State Water Board, Division of Water Rights. The water right issuance order and the \*DATE(s)\* report\*(s)\* documenting the analysis of water availability will be entered into the file for State-Filed Application A0\*#####\* for consideration in connection with any future petition for assignment. If a petition for assignment of State-Filed Application A0\*#####\* is filed, right holder may file a protest against the petition for assignment in accordance with the applicable requirements of the Water Code and the State Water Board's regulations.
