Notice of Minor Change to Water Right Application A031774

A minor change has been initiated under Water Code section 1700.4 to make minor changes to water right application A031774 of Larry W. Thatcher. The project associated with the application and minor change is in Tehama County and would divert water from the Cottonwood Creek stream system.

Summary of Water Right Application A031774

Date of Filing: The application was filed with the State Water Board on June 5, 2009.

Source of Water: The source of water is an Unnamed Stream, which is tributary to South Fork Cottonwood Creek thence Cottonwood Creek thence the Sacramento River.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water is from November 1 of each year through April 30 of the succeeding year.

Diversion Method and Amount: Water will be collected to onstream storage in Lowell Reservoir and will be limited to 64.5 acre-feet per year.

Point of Diversion: The point where water will be diverted is Lowell Reservoir Dam, located at North 1,948,155 feet and East 6,402,908 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 1, North American Datum 1983, within the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 20, Township 27 North, Range 6 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Purposes of Use: The purposes of use for water are recreational, fire protection, fish culture, and domestic.

Place of Use: The place of use for recreational, fire protection, and fish culture use of water is at Lowell Reservoir, located within the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 20, Township 27 North, Range 6 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian. The place of use for domestic use of water is within the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 20, Township 27 North, Range 6 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Summary of Minor Change

Source of Water: The source of water will not change.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water will not change.

Diversion Method and Amount: The diversion method will not change. The maximum amount of water collected to onstream storage will change to 45 acre-feet per year.

Point of Diversion: The point where water will be diverted will not change.

Purposes of Use: The purposes of use for water will change by removing domestic use and adding incidental domestic use.

Places of Use: The places of use for water will not change.
