Notice of Minor Change to Water Right Application A033150

A minor change has been initiated under Water Code section 1700.4 to make minor changes to water right application A033150 of Lamb Family Vineyards LLC. The project associated with the application and minor change is in Napa County and would divert water from the Wooden Valley Creek stream system.

Summary of Water Right Application A033150

Date of Filing: The application was filed with the State Water Board on September 2, 2020.

Source of Water: The source of water is an Unnamed Stream, which is tributary to Wooden Valley Creek thence Suisun Creek thence Grizzly Bay.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water is from November 1 of each year through April 30 of the succeeding year.

Diversion Method and Amount: Water will be collected to onstream storage and diverted to onstream storage at a rate not to exceed 2.9 cubic feet per second in a single reservoir, and will be limited to 20 acre-feet per year.

Point of Diversion: Water will be diverted from three points:

- The first point where water will be collected and rediverted to storage is located at North 1,897,602 feet and East 6,511,072 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of projected Section 15, Township 6 North, Range 3 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
- The second point where water will be diverted to storage is located at North 1,897,569 feet and East 6,510,858 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of projected Section 15, Township 6 North, Range 3 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
- The third point where water will be diverted to storage is located at North 1,898,171 feet and East 6,540,745 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of projected Section 15, Township 6 North, Range 3 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Purpose of Use: The purpose of use for water is irrigation.

Place of Use: The place of use for irrigation is 29 acres within the following:

- 1 acre within the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 10;
- 7 acres within the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 10;
- 5 acres within the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 10;
- 3 acres within the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 15; and,
- 13 acres within the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 15;

All within Township 6 North, Range 3 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Summary of Minor Change

Source of Water: The source of water will not change.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water will not change.

Diversion Method and Amount: The diversion method and amount will not change.

Point of Diversion: The points where water will be diverted will change to the following locations:

- The first point where water will be collected and rediverted to storage is located at North 1,897,806 feet and East 6,511,301 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of projected Section 15, Township 6 North, Range 3 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
- The second point where water will be diverted to storage is located at North 1,897,604 feet and East 6,510,852 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of projected Section 15, Township 6 North, Range 3 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
- The third point where water will be diverted to storage is located at North 1,897,531 feet and East 6,510,131 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of projected Section 15, Township 6 North, Range 3 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Purpose of Use: The purpose of use for water will not change.

Place of Use: The place of use for water will change by adjusting the location of portions of the place of use, which will result in no change to the place of use size or description in the application. The applicant has provided an updated map to the State Water Board.
