Notice of Minor Change to Water Right Permit 13525

A minor change has been initiated under Water Code section 1700.6 to make minor changes to water right permit 13525 (A017139) of the North Tahoe Public Utility District. The project associated with the permit and minor change is in Placer County and authorizes the diversion of water from the Lake Tahoe stream system.

Summary of Water Right Permit 13525 (A017139)

Priority Date: The priority date is June 18, 1956.

Source of Water: The source of water is Lake Tahoe, which is tributary to the Truckee River thence Pyramid Lake.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water is June 1 to September 30 of each year.

Diversion Method and Amount: Water is diverted by direct diversion, and is limited to 600 acre-feet per year at a rate not to exceed 2.5 cubic feet per second.

Points of Diversion: Water is diverted from two points:

- The first point where water is diverted is North Tahoe Public Utility District's Lake Tahoe Intake located at North 2,218,088 feet and East 7,114,163 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 14, Township 16 North, Range 17 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
- The second point where water is diverted is Old Brockway Golf Course's Lake Tahoe Intake located at North 2,218,188 feet and East 7,119,112 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 13, Township 16 North, Range 17 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Purpose of Use: The purpose of use for water is municipal.

Place of Use: The place of use for water includes two areas:

- North Tahoe Public Utility District's service area, which is approximately 4,200 acres located within all or a portion of sections 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 21, 22, 28, and 33, Township 16 North, Range 17 East, and sections 18, 19, and 30, Township 16 North, Range 18 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

- Old Brockway Golf Course within portions of sections 12 and 13, Township 16 North, Range 17 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Summary of Minor Change PAR-0000037603

Source of Water: The source of water will not change.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water will not change.

Diversion Method and Amount: The maximum amount of water requested for diversion will change to 210 acre-feet per year. The method of diversion and rate of diversion will not change.

Points of Diversion: The points where water will be diverted will be changed by removing North Tahoe Public Utility District's point of diversion.

Purpose of Use: The purpose of use for water will not change.

Place of Use: The place of use will be changed by removing North Tahoe Public Utility District's place of use.
