PROJECT DESCRIPTION: On October 15, 2024, the Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) submitted a water quality certification (certification) amendment application for the Poe Hydroelectric Project (Project). The amendment would allow temporary modifications to Condition 1 (Minimum Instream Flows) and Condition 13 (Tributary Access). A temporary reduction in minimum instream flow (MIF) is needed to complete dam safety maintenance on the radial bypass gate, specifically, recoating the gate, replacing seals, and replacing the hoist and controls. PG&E proposes to lower MIF to 100 cfs from June 1, 2025, through November 15, 2025. Because lowering MIF will impact tributary access monitoring, PG&E proposes to delay monitoring until the next Critically Dry water year type if 2025 is classified as a Critically Dry water year. This public notice updates the date of conclusion of PG&E's proposed temporary reduction in MIF from November 1, 2025, to November 15, 2025.
